The Merkabah Retreats: A movement from theory to practice.

If you are ready to advance from studying metaphysical and spiritual theory to full immersion into the mystical transformative process itself, the Merkabah Retreats could be your next step. The Merkabah retreats are an opportunity to enter into the practical work of the western mystery tradition. The sacred chanting, esoteric meditations and attunements to the initiatic current of energy stimulate highly specific spiritual growth in the participant as well as an accelerated unfoldment of mystical abilities. Each program is designed to affect a distinct aspect of spiritual unfoldment. Through these retreats we will focus our intent upon transforming our subtle and gross bodies and linking into progressively higher and more refined energies.

The retreat format has been chosen as an opportunity to surrender deeply to your transformational process. Therefore I suggest that you leave all other projects, reading material, and concerns at home when you arrive. I strongly encourage you to lodge with the group. The extensive meditations and chanting often place people in a deep altered state. Our goal is to raise the vibrational rate of the group and sustain it for prolonged periods. Staying on the facility will give you the luxury of not having to descend prematurely missing a deeper level of transformation.

*The Merkabah Retreats with Joseph Lee are in no way related to the work of Drumvalo Melchizedek, and do not use any of the techniques of his "Flower of Life" seminars, nor his Merkabah meditation. The word Merkabah is an ancient Hebrew and Egyptian word that means "Chariot", and does not refer to any specific teacher's techniques nor their use of that word.

WHAT TO BRING: Clothes appropriate to mountain terrain and weather (We'll be up in the Smoky Mountains), **alcohol is strictly prohibited** by the facility, no smoking in the buildings, please refrain from wearing perfumes and colognes, bring prescription medications, **alarm clock**, etc. Journaling/note-taking will only be permitted during some of the lectures. **You may choose to bring your own bed linens (2 full-sized beds are in each room), towels, pillow and blanket as previous participants were more comfortable with their own linens.** All recording devices are prohibited.

FOOD AND LODGING: Each room at Steiner Bell has two full sized beds, a bath, and balcony (many of which overlook the Smoky mountains). Private rooms are sometimes available for an additional fee. Wholesome simple food choices have been made from the catering possibilities. A limited number of vegan or vegetarian meals can be specially ordered.

LOCATION & DIRECTIONS: Wa-Floy Village (Steiner-Bell facility) 3610 East Parkway Gatlinburg, TN

Directions from Knoxville Airport (Alcoa/Maryville TN) to Wa-Floy Mtn. Village and Steiner Bell Lodge by car: (Distance: 52.2 Miles – Travel time: 1.5 hours. Begin by setting your mile meter to zero.) Leaving the Knoxville Airport take the ramp marked “129S-Maryville/Alcoa”. As you continue on 129 bear left at the fork toward “Maryville, Townsend, Smokey Mtns, to N411 to N321”. At 4.1 miles you'll cross “Lamar Alexander Pkwy” and continue forward on 321 north. At 21.9 miles turn left to continue on 321 north. At 37.2 miles turn right to follow 321 north. At 46.1 miles turn left at Light #3 to follow 321 north. At 52.2 miles turn right into the “Steiner-Bell Lodge”.

Wa-Floy Village is a large complex of buildings nestled in the Smokies, complete with running brooks, pioneer trails, and deep silent groves. Time will be available for hiking and quiet walking meditations.

By Air: Fly into Knoxville TN Airport, rent a car there and follow the directions above.

FEE: The Retreat Fee is \$410.00 per person (Make check or money order payable to “Joseph Lee”). The fee includes double occupancy lodging, meals, and tuition. (If **POSTMARKED** by October 15, 2007 \$410.00. If **POSTMARKED after** October 15, 2007 \$465.00. No exceptions will be made.) You are encouraged to contribute to a scholarship fund that will be used to offer full or partial scholarships to aspirants in need who wish to attend the 20th Merkabah.

SCHOLARSHIPS: If you are committed to The Work but are unable to attend due to financial difficulties you can apply for a scholarship. Fill out the complete registration form. Enclose a check for the maximum amount you can afford. You will be notified if matching funds become available. You will be required to participate in a work-study program that will involve various duties during the program. All scholarship recipients will be required to arrive at 1:00 PM on 10/19/07. If scholarship funds do not become available your check will be returned.

CANCELLATION POLICY: All registration funds are **Non-Refundable**. (Way-Floy Village has a non-refund policy. If you cancel your retreat reservation, Wa-Floy Village will still charge me as if you were there! So it is necessary that I establish a non-refund policy as well.) If you cannot attend after registration, your fee will be used in the 20th Merkabah scholarship pool. *Exception:* Registrants who register with partial payment waiting for matching scholarship will receive a full refund if matching funds do not become available.
